

Adolescent Bullying in Missouri...

- The most commonly reported form of bullying is making fun of other people. The majority of students (~90%) did <u>not</u> engage in cyber bullying or cell phone bullying.
- All bullying questions show a decrease from 2010 to 2012.
- The 2012 survey also asked youth if they had "Hit, shoved or pushed another student and was not just fooling around?" in the last three months; 19.6% reported that they had.
- Typically, more people report being a victim of bullying than being the perpetrator.
- Males are much more likely (26% vs. 14%) to report physical bullying. Females are slightly more likely to engage in the other types of bullying.
- Physical bullying decreases with age. Other types of bullying do not have as clear of a pattern with regards to age.
