Assessments for Non-Residential Level of Care (LOC) Renewals

Designated assessors will begin scheduling and completing all adaptive assessments for **Non-Residential LOC Renewal Assessments** in February 2024.

The designated assessor will initiate assessment efforts approximately ninety (90) days prior to the LOC due date. The assessor is responsible for contacting the individual, informant, and other responsible persons. If the assessor is unable to contact the individual and/or informant, the support coordinator may be asked to assist with communication efforts. The Division is developing a quarterly report to inform targeted case management (TCM) entities when to anticipate assessment actions for individuals authorized with the agency.

As a reminder, support coordinators should **not** initiate assessment scheduling for **Non-Residential Renewal Assessments**. Going forward, supports coordinators should only initiate scheduling for these adaptive assessment needs:

- Initial Waiver Requests
- Critical Service Situations
- Residential LOC Renewals
